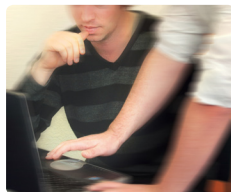


Youth Work

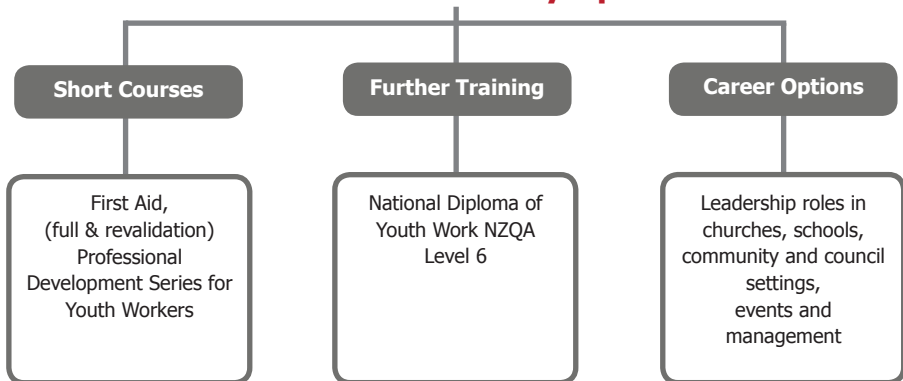

- **Quality Relationships**

Explore the structure of social service agencies.

Put into practice the knowledge and skills you have acquired.
