Youth Training is free to eligible learners. Learners will continue to receive any benefits they are on and may also be eligible for a travel allowance.

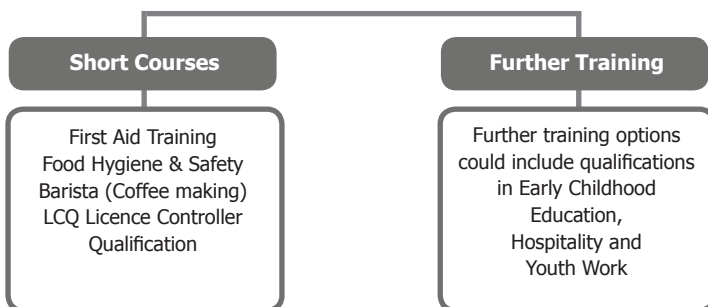
Objectives and Outcomes:

- To complete units towards the National Certificate in Employment Skills, NZQA Level 1.
- Gain NZQA unit standards towards ECE, Level 3.
- To ascertain skills and abilities to develop self worth, including literacy and numeracy.
- To enhance the programme by providing essential customer service skills and experience.
- To outline an individual plan that sets goals and objectives so that individuals gain units in work place skills.
- To liaise with local industry to obtain work placement and/or employment opportunities.
- To produce a CV and a plan for future direction.

Eligibility:

The students most eligible for this programme are those who are under the age of 18 with low qualifications and who are at risk of long term unemployment.
